



## Ghana • November 4 – 14, 2011

### **Day 01**      **Depart JFK International to Accra, Ghana**

*Nov 04 – Fri*      Arrive at JFK International Airport for check in 3 hours before the flight

### **Day 02**      **Arrival in Accra**

*Nov 05 – Sat*      Arrive in Accra, Ghana clear immigration and customs and proceed to your hotel  
On arrival in Accra, clear immigration and customs and transfer you to your hotel for check in.  
6 pm      Attend the informal reception with drinks and entertainment  
7 pm -1 am      **Gala, Awards Dinner with Cultural entertainment and Dance**  
Hotel:-La Palm Royal Hotel (Dinner included)

### **Day 03**      **Depart Accra for Hohoe**

*Nov 06 – Sun*      Depart Accra for Hohoe in the Volta Region of Ghana.  
On arrival we will visit **Wli Water Falls** and **Tafi Monkey Sanctuary**  
Overnight at Wli Water Heights Hotel

### **Day 04**      **Hohoe – Jasikan - Akosombo**

*Nov 07 – Mon*      Proceed to **Okadjakrom** where you will spend the day in the village, courtesy call on the chief and elders; visit the local school, walk through the village and learn firsthand about village life in Ghana before returning to Akosombo  
Overnight at Volta Hotel Akosombo

### **Day 05**      **Akosombo – Kumasi Craft Villages**

*Nov 08 – Tue*      You will depart **Akosombo** for Kumasi after touring the **Dam** and visit enroute Ejisu Besease and the craft villages of Ashantis to **Bonwire** where the world famous kente cloth is woven, **Ntonso** which is home to the traditional Adinkra cloth and **Ahwiaa** for woodcarving.  
Overnight at Golden Tulip Hotel Kumasi – **(Breakfast & Lunch)**

### **Day 06**      **Kumasi Cultural Orientation**

*Nov 09 – Wed*      After breakfast this morning, you will embark on a tour of Kumasi visiting the **Manhyia Palace** where you will see replicas of old kings and royal stools of the Ashantis. You will also visit **King Prempeh II Museum, Okomfo Anokye** sword site where a legendary sword is driven into the ground by this famous priest several centuries ago. Further tours will take you to the **Cultural Center** where you will see artists at work  
Overnight at Golden Tulip Hotel Kumasi – (Breakfast & Lunch)

### **Day 07**      **Kumasi – Elmina Castle**

*Nov 10 – Thu*      You will depart Kumasi for Elmina. Upon arrival you will visit the **Elmina Castle** which was built by the Portuguese in 1482. You will be guided through the slave dungeons, the Door of No Return, etc.  
Overnight at Elmina Bay – (Breakfast & Lunch)

### **Day 08**      **Cape Coast Castle – Kakum National Park**

*Nov 11 – Fri*      After breakfast, depart for **Kakum National Park**. You will have the choice between walking the trails with a guide to explore the cultural and medicinal uses of the plants in the forest or for the more adventuresome the canopy walkway will provide a bird's eye view of the forest. Enjoy lunch at Hans Cottage Botel then to **Cape Coast Castle** for a tour.  
Overnight in Elmina Bay – (Breakfast & Lunch)

### **Day 09**      **Elmina – Accra**

*Nov 12 – Sat*      After breakfast depart for Accra.  
Hotel:-La Palm Royal Hotel (Breakfast)

### **Day 10**      **Accra Free Day**

*Nov 13 – Sun*      *Free day for church attendance or rest*  
Hotel:-La Palm Royal Hotel (Breakfast)

### **Day 11**      **Depart Accra – Arrive at JFK, NY**

Nov 14 – Mon Today you will transfer to the airport to board your flight to the US. Arrive in NY this same day.
